Conditions

1. Full school uniform is required unless specified.

3. Students are responsible for taking precautions to reduce risks from sun exposure. This includes, but is not limited to, appropriate clothing, a hat and sunscreen.
4. Every attempt will be made to contact parents in the case of accident and illness but students attend excursions on the understanding that emergency medical help will be sought if required.

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PLAN

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

In the event of Lockdown/Lockout/Evacuation

- Students will be taken to the nearest local public school.
- Parents will then be notified by the teacher in charge and via sms from KHS
- If a person other than the parent/caregiver is picking up the student they will need to have written permission from the parent/caregiver.

BUSHFIRE EVACUATION

- Students will be evacuated to the nearest 'safe place' as directed by the NSW RFS
- Parents will then be contacted by the teacher in charge and via sms from KHS

WATER BASED EXCURSIONS

- If this excursion involves students participating in water based activities could you make sure that you fill in the appropriate section on the permission note.

USE OF PRIVATE VEHICLES

- If students are travelling by private vehicles to and from this excursion, a separate permission note must be completed by drivers and passengers.
